These character qualifications are rooted in 1 Timothy 4:12a. This is accomplished by setting an example in:

- **In Speech**
 - Each team member is expected to speak in a manner that brings glory to God at all times. Regardless of the setting we find ourselves in, we are to have the wisdom and maturity to use our tongue to **bring life and not death**. We will uphold a concerted focus when writing things for this organization that is altogether: **accurate, loving, fearless, excellent**, and most importantly **thought provoking**.
- **In Conduct**
 - Each team member is expected to conduct themselves as a disciple of Christ; recognizing that their actions (both positive and negative) directly reflects upon MMCM's organization. Furthermore, we are to **immediately** report any action (directly or indirectly) associated with ourselves that may bring reproach to this organization. **A servant's mindset** is expected as a contributor to this ministry. Therefore, as a viable partner to our ministry we will make every effort to answer the call of our position; putting forth **our best effort**. We are to treat our position as an offering unto the Lord; leaving no energy left unused. **Simply put, treat this ministry as our own**. - **In Love**
